

## Choosing your Saint

### Report must include the following:

- Why do you connect with your saint?
- How do they inspire you to want to become a better Catholic?
- What are they the patron saint of?
- How did they become a saint?
- When is their feast day?

### Media Report

1-2 min video.

1. You can make a PowerPoint presentation to present with pictures and facts on your saint and why they inspire you.
2. You can get your whole family or friends involved and create a skit about your saint.
  - a. Your skit live/recorded can be a breaking news story, autobiography etc.
3. Or you can:
  - a. A creative news front page article/ aged scroll
  - b. A poster board with facts and pictures
  - c. A written traditional report (1 page, double spaced, Times New Roman, 11 font size)
  - d. Write a poem about your saint's life, what they mean to you and what you wish for the future.
  - e. Comic book strip or mini booklet (also must include the above about your saint on the back of the drawing or painting)
  - f. Drawing or painting (also must include the above about your saint on the back of the drawing or painting)

The purpose of this assignment is to show your talents, your ability to work together as a family, with your friends.

If you are working in a group with students from the program, make sure each one of you make something of the saint you chose. (Ex. If there are 3 of you working together, you will have 3 different reports of 3 different saints for each of you in your group.)

**Your projects will be due the latest by December 8<sup>th</sup>.
